5. Use ingredients that are readily available in grocery stores.
6. Type or legibly write recipe on 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of paper with name, address, daytime and evening phone number, email address if available, in the upper right hand corner. Entries must be legible and include a phone number and or e-mail address or they will be disqualified.
7. Upon submission, recipes will become property of the Robeson Regional Agricultural Fair and King Arthur Flour, which reserves the right to edit, adapt, copyright, publish and use for publicity, promotion or advertising without compensation.
8. Contestants may submit more than one type of submission, but only one entry per participant can win.
9. This contest is open to all ages; amateurs only.
10. To be a contestant, mail entry form and recipe to: King Arthur Flour Baking Contest, Attn: Janice Fields, P. O. Box 2280, Lumberton, NC 28359, postmarked by October 3, 2015. Or you may drop off your entry form and recipe at the Robeson County Cooperative Extension Center, 455 Caton Road, Lumberton, NC 28360 by Monday October 5, 2015
11. Fair committee selects judges; judges' decisions are final.
12. Entry will need to serve 3-6 judges.
13. No team entries, this contest is for individual competition.
14. The cooking contest coordinator and/or contest sponsor reserves the right to make any changes or decisions prior to or during the contest as deemed necessary. Their decision will be final.
